Transporting Children To & From Matches and Training Policy

Royal Ascot Cricket Club

Parents/carers are responsible for the safe delivery and collection of their child for matches or training.

All fixtures are published in the Club Fixture Card and also on royalascot.play-cricket.com. However, please be aware that matches may be rearranged due to weather or other issues so your age group manager will notify you of any fixture changes.

Coaches and club managers / officials will be responsible for children in our care when on the club premises or on arrival at opponents' cricket grounds.

It is not the responsibility of the coach or team manager to transport, or arrange to transport, the children to and from the club or match.

The club through the relevant age group manager must receive permission from parents/carers for children to participate in all competitions and away fixtures/events.

For training and matches you must notify the club manager or official who is taking the register for the relevant training session or in charge of the match if you are not staying for the duration of the training session or match and / or if another parent/carer is collecting the child at the end of the session and that the club manager or official has your contact details.

If you're going to be late in collecting your child then it is your responsibility to let the club manager or official know of any issue.

The child will remain with a club manager or official and if we have not heard from you then we will try and contact you to establish what the issue is until they're collected.

In the event of repeat late collection then the issue will be raised to the Club Welfare Officer and the club retains the right to withdraw membership from the club.
